Eran Efrati, is the Executive Director of the *Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions-USA*, and an investigative researcher of the Israeli military. He formerly served as the chief researcher for *Breaking the Silence*, where he collected testimonies from hundreds of IDF soldiers about their activities. Since leaving *Breaking the Silence*, his investigative reports have appeared in *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, and *The Guardian*. Today his research focuses on international military and police partnerships and the global arms trade. He has worked with the *International Criminal Court* and has participated in both independent and UN investigations into Israeli military operations.

Maya Wind, currently a doctoral student in Social and Cultural Analysis at NYU, co-founded the *Shministim* group of Israeli conscientious objectors in 2008, and was sentenced to military prison. Since her release she has been active with civil society organizations, including the *Israeli Committee Against House Demolitions* & *New Profile: The Feminist Movement to Demilitarize Israeli Society*.
